


Langhe ebike food and wine tour

he Langhe is a historic Italian region located in the south of Piedmont, in the province of Cuneo.

This is a hilly area known for producing red wines. Among these wines you can find Barolo, Nebbiolo, Barbaresco and Dolcetto d'Alba.

If the 'Bassa Langa' is important for wines and for the white truffle, 'Alta Langa' instead is the area where you can find woods and the hazelnut cultivation. The Langhe can offer different and evocative landscapes in all seasons. What always remains the same in all seasons is cooking.

There are many good restaurants where you can taste the traditional Piedmontese dishes prepared with the excellent products of the area. And after a good lunch you can walk among the villages reaching castles and admiring unexpected views.

TOUR OVERVIEW

This tour will make you feel the e-bike, food & wine experience in three main areas: Langa del Barolo, Langa del Barbaresco, and Alta Langa.





CHARACTERISTICS OF THE ROUTE

You predominantly cycle along quiet secondary roads.

The area is completely hilly, that's why e-bike is included in the price. Most of the route is on tarmac. Only short sections are on gravel paths.

When arriving and leaving the towns there are short connecting sections where you should be expecting more traffic.


Free visit of Alba historical centre, the most important town in the Langhe, founded before the Romans and also known as the 100-towerstown.

Highlights: visit a local winery and taste some **Barbaresco** wines
Treiso, Neviglie and Mango are the first villages to visit today.

The discovery of the Langhe starts with the village of Barbaresco, where the roman Emperor Elvio Pertinace was born.


Today the fame, the glory and pride of this small town is entrusted to the wine Barbaresco and to the art of winemakers, considered the most refined in the area.

Then visit Neive, awarded as one of the most beautiful villages in Italy. **Options**: you can visit the medieval 30 metres high Tower of Barbaresco (not included).

Hihghlights: today you can start your tour visiting Monforte d'Alba, Barolo, La Morra, Novello the very heart of the 'Langa del Barolo'.

Monforte is famous for its Jazz festival (July and August) held in the precious venue of the Horszowski Auditorium. In Barolo don't miss the Wine Museum hosted in the Marquis Falletti Castle.


Today you'll learn how to cook local 'tajarin' in a special cooking class in **Roddi**. You'll discover if you've been good at cooking tasting them for lunch.

Approx 20~25 km


Highlights: Today you can reach Alba and spend your time enjoying among shops, bars and restaurant.

Hihghlights: visit Roddino, Dogliani, Monchiero and Novello.

Finish your ride in Novello with its stunning views from two opposite sightseeing points.

All of these villages host an endless number of wineries producing Dolcetto, Barbera, Nebbiolo and... of course the King of Wines: Barolo. You'll visit one typical cellar in Novello and tasting local wine. You'll discover that the special typical Novello's wine is - among a lot of red wines - one white wine. Its name is Nas-cetta.

Options: visit to WiMu – Wine Museum in Barolo.

Approx 30~40 km


Highlights: You'll pedal to
Mombarcaro in Alta Langa. You'll find
a different landscape made by higher
hills, less vineyards and more
hazelnuts, woods and wheat fields.
You'll visit a local cheese producer
and discover everything about the
pastures, sheep and goats and you'll
taste different types of cheese.

Options: in order to reach easier Mombararo you can choose the trasportation by van in a different place to start the tour. Winetasting in one of our partner wineries; visits to Grinzane Cavour Castle and/or Serralunga Castle (not included).
